Format: **FOUR-PERSON SCRAMBLE:** All players drive from every tee. The team selects the ball they want to play and all four players hit from that spot. This procedure stays in effect until the ball is holed. Players may place the ball within one club length of the selected shot, no closer to the hole. The ball must remain in the same condition. Example: if the ball is in the rough, the club length may not take the ball out of the rough. On the putting green, the ball may be placed within six inches of the selected shot, no closer to the hole. Do not make tap-ins until all players have attempted the original putt—once the ball is holed, that score counts! ****In the interest of pace of play, a maximum score of Bogey will be used for the tournament.****

Tees: Gentlemen will play from the WHITE tee markers. Land Tee #16

Ladies will play from the GREEN tee markers.

Rules: USGA Rules govern all play, except where modified by the Local Rules in the inside panel of the scorecard.

Prizes: 1st - 3rd and Last Place

Ties: All ties will be decided by scorecard play-off starting on the men's number 1 handicap hole progressing until a winner is determined.

Special Instructions:

1. Fix your ball marks
2. Fill your divots
3. Rake your bunkers
4. Follow the days cart rules
 - Cart paths only on all par 3's
 - Follow the no carts signs fronting the greens
5. Good luck, play well, and have fun!

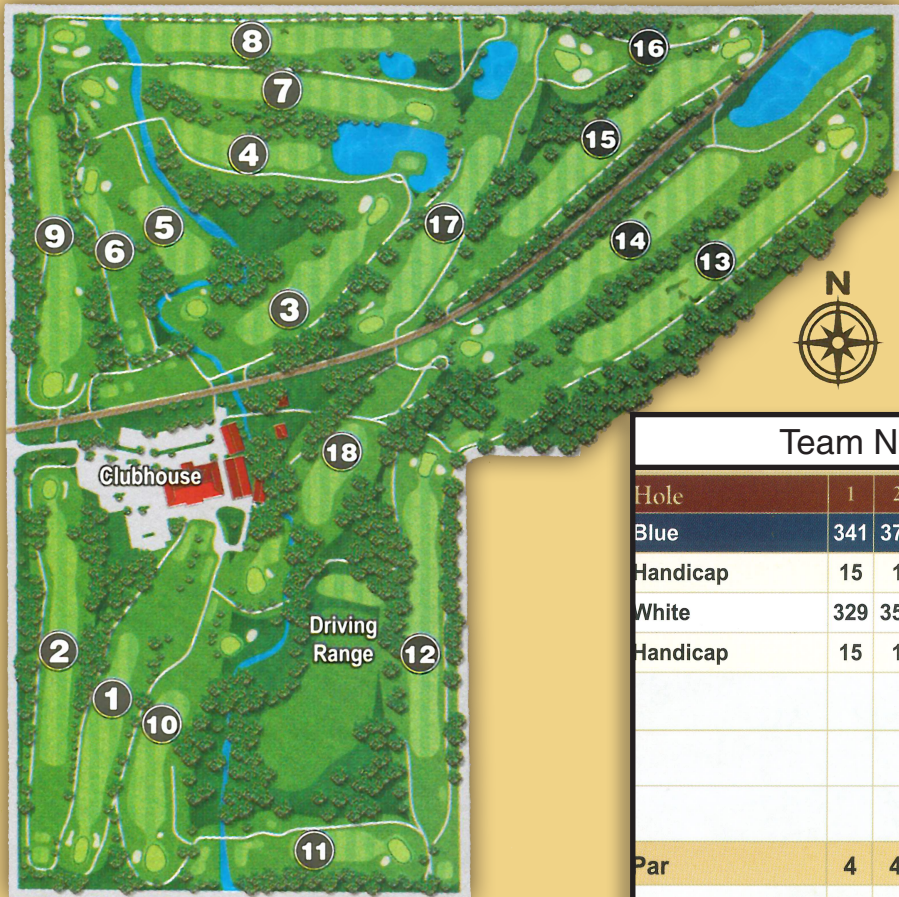
